

E-11 Ball Deflected by Power Line

SRPGA Local Rule, adopted January 10, 2019

Not Optional

If it is known or virtually certain that a player's ball hit a power line (or a tower, a wire, or a pole supporting a power line) during the play of a hole, the stroke does not count.

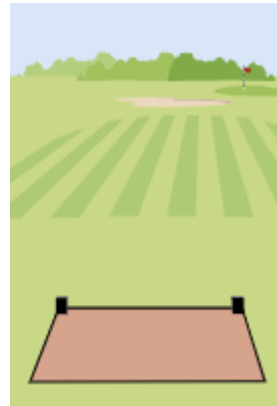
The player *must* play a ball without penalty from where the previous stroke was made (see Rule 14.6 for what to do).

This rule does not apply for power lines that do not interfere with play of a hole or are out of bounds.



Rule 14.6 Making Next Stroke from Where Previous Stroke Made

Tee Shot. If the stroke was made from the teeing area, a ball must be played from anywhere inside the teeing area.



General Area, Bunker, Penalty Area. If the stroke was made from the general area, a bunker or from a penalty area, the reference spot is the spot where the previous stroke was made.

A ball is dropped within one club length of that reference point, but *in the same area of the course as the reference point* and not nearer the hole than the reference point.
